ProAg of Renville County, in collaboration with Agriculture Future of American (AFA), is happy to announce a scholarship opportunity for Renville County high school seniors. Applicants must be pursuing a career in agriculture, live in Renville County, and be accepted at either a 2 or 4 year school. The scholarship is \$4200. **Deadline TODAY**.
