We will be going to the Destination Playground at the popular Robin's Island Park in Willmar. This is a full accessible playground built in 2017 by hundreds of volunteers who worked through the cold, wind and rain to build the 19,000 square-foot, fully accessible playground for children. The playground is one of the largest fully accessible playgrounds in the country. There are the usual favorites such as swings, slides and monkey bars, but also ramps, a swing and zip line that accommodate those in wheelchairs. A rubberized surface was also installed to prevent big injuries. This playground is truly one-of-a-kind and is a must see!

After playing at the Destination Playground, we'll be traveling to Willmar's Rice Park Splash Pad! There are sprinkler-like water sprays providing fun for everyone. Located near the playground of Rice Park. With blooming flowers sprinkling and spouting water along the way, the Splash Pad at Rice Park is a great way to cool off when the temperatures soar. A section of the pad is geared for 3-5 year olds alongside the other areas geared for all ages to enjoy. Changing rooms and restrooms are available on site.
