A few reminders:

- *Hats need to be removed BEFORE entering the building.

- * Your mask needs to be on (covering your nose and mouth) upon entering the building. Please follow this requirement. ***Also masks must remain covering your nose and mouth until you get outside the building.
 - *Please social distance when in school. Six feet apart is the required distance.

Football Game Reminders: As a school district, we are required to follow state guidance when hosting athletic events. Below are some reminders for the rules that must be followed by all in attendance.

- Masks: Masks must be worn when entering and exiting the facility. Masks also must be worn whenever 6 feet of social distancing cannot take place. Each individual at the game must assume this responsibility.
- Social distancing: Students must keep 6 feet of social distance from other students. Fans are encouraged to bring lawn chairs if they would like to sit and bleacher space is not available.
- After the game: All fans must leave the facility immediately after the game. Pictures and other post game gatherings are not allowed. Lights will be turned off as soon as the officials and opposing team are able to leave.
- Students who do not follow these guidelines will not be eligible to attend the next game.
